**6:30 am Mass**—To encourage attendance at daily Mass as a Lenten commitment, we have added a 3rd Mass during the season of Lent. From now through Wed., April 12 there will be Mass at 6:30 am from Monday through Friday.

**Abstinence All Fridays** - All Catholics 14 years and older are to abstain from meat on **all Fridays of Lent (exception 3/17/17)**.  
**Fasting**—All Catholics ages 18—59. Two secondary meals together must be less in quantity than the primary meal.

## Gospel Recap: “You Can Give Living Water Too”

The Samaritan woman comes to a well looking for water but finds something that quenches her deepest thirst—Jesus Christ. She responds by telling everyone in town because she cannot contain herself! And the Gospel says many people followed Jesus because of her. This is truly a courageous woman. Scholars write that her reputation with multiple husbands made her an outsider. She was also a Samaritan, from an ethnic group that many Jews looked down on as racially and ethnically flawed. Our lesson for this week is we can learn from those in society that are most excluded or criticized. They often find Jesus quickly because others turn their backs on them. We can take “living water” to others by talking openly about faith and the difference Jesus makes in our lives.
