Rita of Cascia, 1381-1457

Born near Spoleto, Italy, Rita wanted to be a nun but married in deference to her parents. For nearly twenty years, she endured her profligate husband’s mistreatment. Following his violent death, she was admitted after three refusals to an Augustinian convent at Cascia, where she spent the next forty years. She is remembered for her devoted care of sick nuns and for a deep forehead wound that lasted fifteen years, caused she said by a thorn from Christ’s crown of thorns. She has a large, popular following and is invoked during difficult or impossible situations.
