

Home is Holy: Who is calling you? Are you listening?

We often reach out to God asking for help with our problems and answers to our prayers. But like any conversation, we need to allow time for God to talk to us too. In today's readings, we heard about how God called Samuel. At first Samuel didn't realize that God was calling him, but when he understood, his response was "Speak Lord, your servant is listening!" In a similar way, the first disciples followed Jesus and listened to what he was telling them. Next time you pray, take a little time to be quiet and listen to what God wants to say to you. Most often God's message is a very simple one—God wants you to know that you are special to him, and that he loves you very much!






