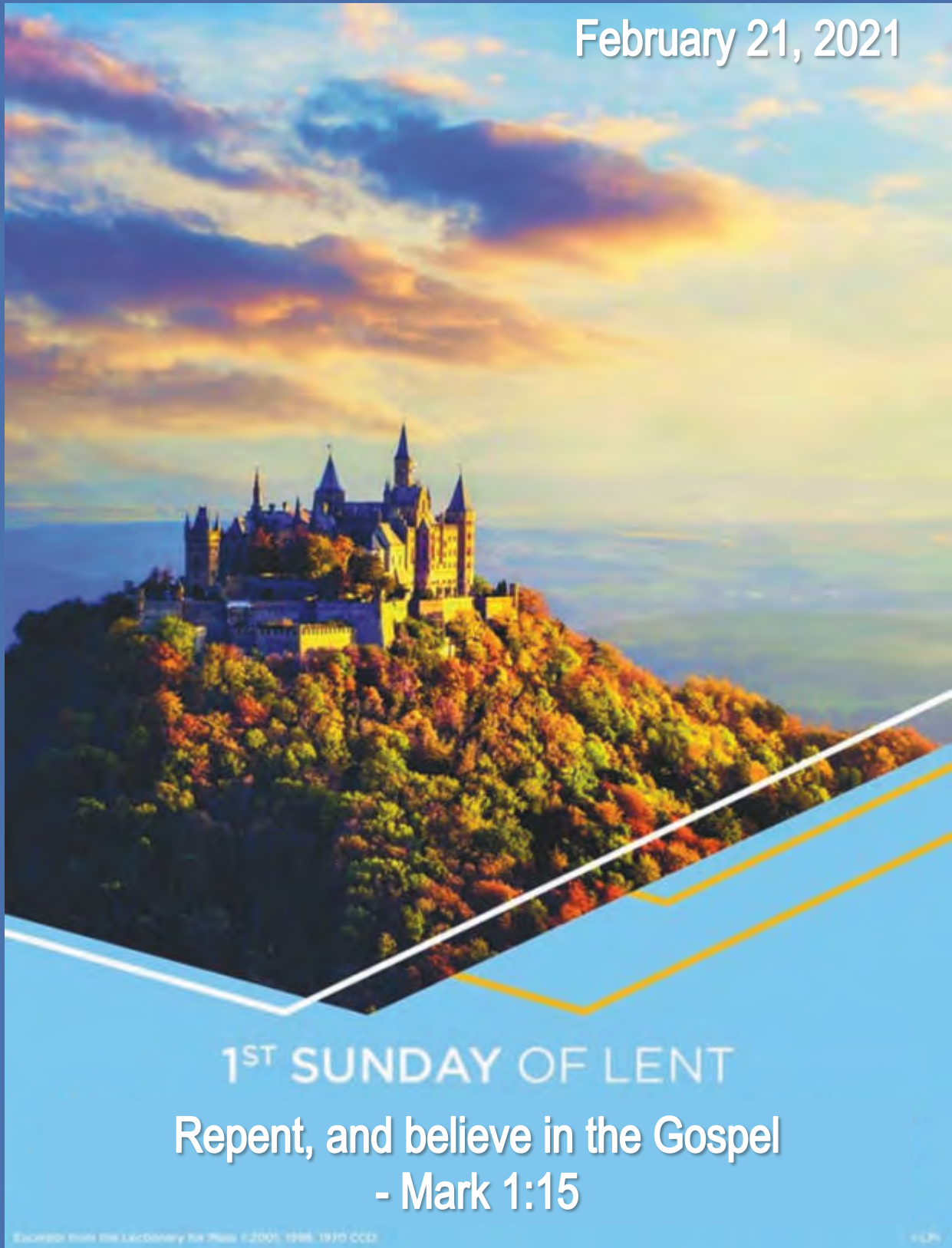

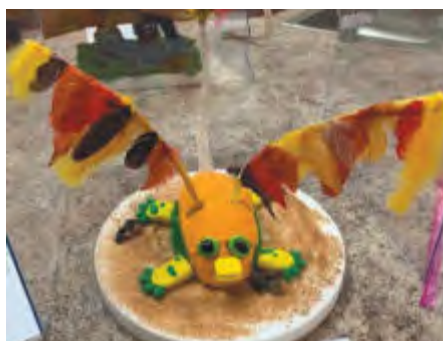




Animal Adaptations

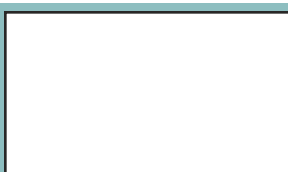
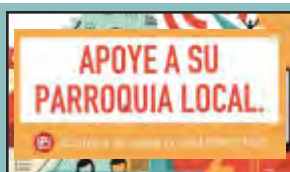
