Home is Holy: The Good Shepherd

Today is Good Shepherd Sunday. We hear Jesus telling us he is our shepherd. Sheep will only follow the voice of their shepherd, because they know they can trust him. They feel safe with the shepherd and know they won't get harmed. Jesus wants us to follow his voice, which tells us that we can trust him because he always wants what is best and most life-giving for us. If people are hired to watch the sheep, when danger comes they might run off to protect themselves instead of the sheep. Jesus is saying that he will never abandon us, just as he didn't abandon his disciples. Jesus is always here for us, even in our most difficult times. Today after the 9 AM Mass, children will receive a toy lamb inside an Easter egg, to remind them of our call to follow the Good Shepherd.
