


Can Your Family Help Another Family?

Saint of the Week: "St. Martin de Porres"

St. Martin, a patron of the poor, was born in Peru in 1579. He was the son of a Spanish knight and a Black mother. During his youth, he was apprenticed to a barber-surgeon, and became very knowledgeable of medicines and herbs, which he later used in his care of the poor. He became a lay brother of the Dominican Order of priests, and is most remembered for his care of the slaves who were brought to Peru from Africa. He once said, "I wish to be the slave of the slaves of God." Upon his death in 1639, he was carried to his grave by bishops and noblemen. He is appropriately the patron of Social Justice. 
