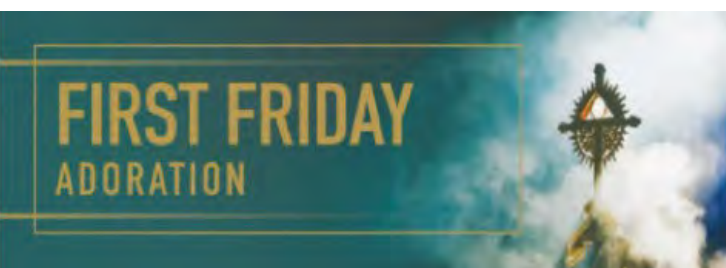
Mass Intentions at St. John Fisher
