## **Thoughts on Father Thomas Park's Departure**

When Father Park came to me two weeks ago telling me that he would be requesting a transfer to another parish, I was surprised and saddened. I was surprised because I did not see it coming. I was saddened because I appreciated his being here. He came as a newly ordained priest and was open to learning about how to minister to the people at St. John Fisher Church. When he told me his need to be geographically closer to aging parents, I understood and supported his decision. I was pleased to hear that the Archdiocese decided to transfer him to St. Monica Church, in Santa Monica, because I knew he would be just a few minutes away from where his parents lived.

When Father Park leaves, I am not caught shorthanded. The Archdiocese has assigned as his replacement Monsignor Charles Chaffman. I have known him for many years; since I was a young priest and he was attending the high school seminary. You will learn more about him in the weeks to come.

Father Park's transfer takes place July 1, so you will have plenty of time to bid him farewell. I am grateful for the brief time he was with us.

## **New Procedures for the Sunday Collection**

When we were first hit with the pandemic, out of caution we changed the procedure for handling your donations to the church. To avoid direct contact with each other, we asked you to come forward and drop it in one of the bins in front of the altar. Next weekend we will return to the pre-Covid procedure. During the offertory, the ushers will pass the baskets to where you are sitting and then put all the offerings from those baskets into one large basket where it will be presented to the priest along with the bread and wine. This is a clearer sign of the relationship between your sacrificial offering with the offering of Jesus who sacrificed himself for our sake. So, if you come into church and do not see the bins by the altar, do not panic. Just wait for the offertory. You will still have the option of electronic giving either through the QR code in the cards in the envelope rack in the pew or through a regular commitment through Faith Direct. I personally prefer that approach and drop in the basket my personalized Faith Direct card as a sign of my personal offering to the Lord.

### Home is Holy: Pentecost Sunday

Happy birthday to us! Today, Pentecost Sunday, is known as the birthday of the church. We celebrate that on this day almost 2,000 years ago, God sent the Holy Spirit to be with us always. Jesus' disciples saw tongues of fire come over each of them and suddenly they could speak and understand many different languages. They changed from people who were hiding out in fear to suddenly being brave and courageous in telling about Jesus's life and his teachings. Even though Jesus wasn't with them anymore as a real, live, walking and talking person, the Holy Spirit came

to be with them and stay with them forever. With the Holy Spirit's help in spreading Jesus' story, suddenly many more people began to believe in him. All of those early believers became the first members of the church, which is why we say the church was born on Pentecost.

### First Communion Preparation

First Communion is a two-year program that is usually begun in the first grade. Children must attend Religious Education classes or the Parish School for two years prior to making First Communion. If you would like to have your child make his or her First Communion, call or e-mail the Religious Education office to receive registration information.
