PRE-SCHOOL/KINDERGARTEN

Pre-School/Kindergarten Religious Education is offered on Sunday mornings for children aged 3 (by October 1) through Kindergarten, 9-10 am.

GRADES 1-8

Classes meet weekly from late September through early May, at St. John Fisher.

Class Schedule:

- Sundays from 10:45 am to 12:00 noon
- ♦ Tuesday afternoons from 4-5:15 pm (Grades 1-5 only) Classes are taught by volunteer catechists. Volunteer catechists are always needed, and receive training, support, and resources. All parents are asked to support the program by occasionally helping in the classroom or assisting with outreach projects.

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD



Children who wish to participate in Liturgy of the Word for Children are dismissed from the 9 am Mass to hear the scriptures in a child-friendly format. This program is open to all children, grades 1 through 6. No registration is needed. Children hear the Word of God proclaimed in their sacred space, and return to their parents in Church at the time of the offertory. Volunteers needed! SACRAMENT PREPARATION

Preparation for **First Reconciliation and First Eucharist** is a two-year process. Generally children begin in Grade 1, but they may begin at any age. Students enroll in their appropriate grade level Religious Education classes. In addition, several special workshops for parents



addition, several special workshops for parents and children in the second year of preparation will be held during the school year. Families are directly involved in all Sacramental programs. **Baptism for Children Grade 1 and above** is called Rite of Christian Initiation. This process is family-centered. Children are expected to enroll in Religious Education classes according to

expected to enroll in Religious Education classes according to their grade level. The Coordinator of Religious Education will contact each family after Religious Education registration is complete.

WHAT IS REPA?

IMPORTANT NOTE ABOUT YOUR FEES:

Our fees have remained the same since 2014. Religious Education Fees do NOT cover all the expenses of the Religious Education program. The total cost per child is about \$350 per child per year. All families are expected to contribute financially to St. John Fisher Parish. For this reason, we must charge additional fees for families that are not registered in the parish.

Your child's Religious Education is more important than paying the full fee. If the fee is a hardship for your family, please pay what you can.
