Home is Holy: Go and Do Likewise

Have you heard the famous story of the Good Samaritan before? It is one of Pope Francis' favorite stories so he talks and writes about it a lot. A man who met Jesus knew he was supposed to love his neighbor as himself, but he wanted to know from Jesus who his neighbors were. It's like he was asking Jesus' permission to not have to be loving to everyone! Well, Jesus told the story of the Good Samaritan as an answer, and it surprised the man. It turns out that two religious people didn't stop to help the person who was beat up, but a stranger did. Jesus told the man to be like that stranger. Pope Francis says that sometimes we're like every character in the story: sometimes we're the person who hurts someone else, sometimes we're the person who needs help, sometimes we ignore people who need help, and sometimes we're the ones who stop to help. He asks us to try to be like the helper more.

First Communion Preparation

First Communion is a two-year program that is usually begun in the first grade. Children must attend Religious Education classes or the Parish School for two years prior to making First Communion. Gospel Recap: "A Story That Needs Retelling"

Just days after the catastrophic events of September 11, in 2001, an angry mob gathered blocks from a Chicago area mosque. The mob marched down toward the mosque to seek revenge for the 9/11 attacks in America. Mob members apparently reasoned that all Muslims are terrorists because a few Muslims used their faith to justify mass murder. Religious bigotry, which caused so much hatred in Jesus' time, is alive and well in our time. So, what did Jesus say about it all? This week's Gospel tells us the answer. Many Jews during Jesus' time shunned Samaritans because they were the descendants of Jews who had married people from different ethnic and religious backgrounds. So, Jesus must've shaken this scholar of the Law and his prejudices when he made the Samaritan the good guy in this story. The mosque mentioned above, was able to find protection on that night in 2001, and later, many brave local Christians spoke out against religious bigotry that ended up igniting the march. Thus, they retold a story of the Good Samaritan in their own words. Is that a story that you are willing to share, too?

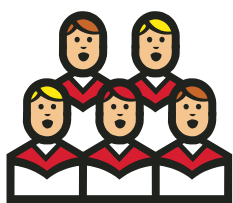

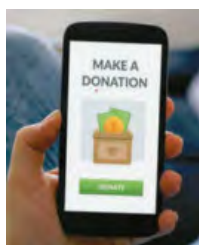
Come Join the Summer Choir!

Did you Know? Check your smoke alarms

The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) recommends that smoke alarms be installed on every level of the home, inside every bedroom, and outside every sleeping area. Keep alarms away from drafts caused by fans or air ducts, as this could blow smoke away from the sensor. The NFPA also recommends that you test your alarms at least once a month, and replace the batteries every six months, or as soon as a low battery chirp is heard. 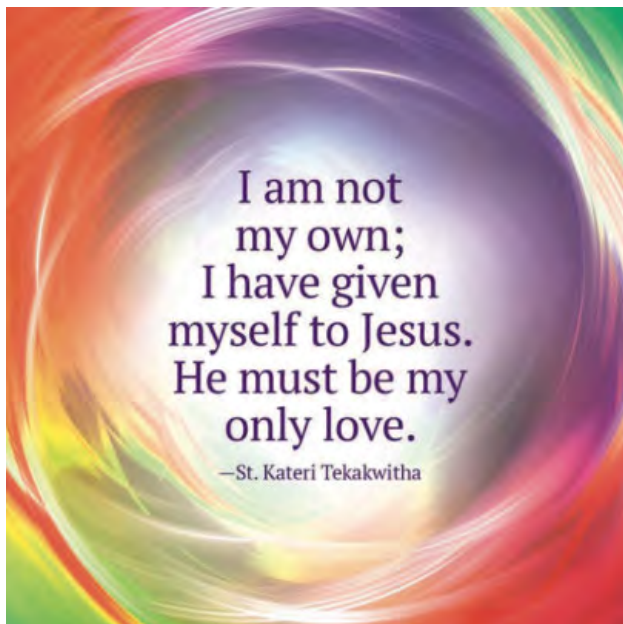

Focusing the Gospel

"Jesus said to him, 'What is written in the law? How do you read it?'" - Luke 10:25-37

Anyone who has taught in any capacity can relate to Jesus and the scholar of the law. Thinking that he can pin Jesus down, the scholar asks what he feels is a challenging question. Jesus spins it back, asking the scholar how the scholar himself interprets it. Classic Socratic method. Jesus commends him, but the scholar isn't finished. He asks Jesus a question a question that many have been intended as petty or insulting, but Jesus answers with one of the most unexpected and memorable parables in all of the gospels: the story of the Good Samaritan, a man who treated an enemy with love and care, doing more than his enemy's own community. (Living Liturgy, 2022)

Faith Sharing Dialog Starters

- Which character in today's gospel do you identify with the most? Is it the scholar questioning Jesus? Is it the man of faith who walks by the man in need? Why do you feel drawn to this particular character?
- Have you ever sidestepped an issue because it made you uncomfortable? Do you see yourself in those who passed by the beaten man?
- Who is your enemy?

Opportunities to Serve at St. John Fisher

Eucharistic Adoration - Spend time in prayer and meditation with our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament one hour a week.
