Jubilee Year - Mass of Thanksgiving



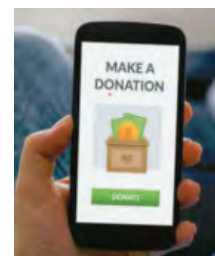

If you were able to invite just five people to your birthday party, who would you include? Now, what if next month one of those five people had a birthday party and didn't invite you? Would you invite that person to your next party? It's normal to expect people to return a kind gesture, isn't it? It seems unfair when they don't. But in this verse, Jesus is reminding us that people have value even if they can't repay our kindness.

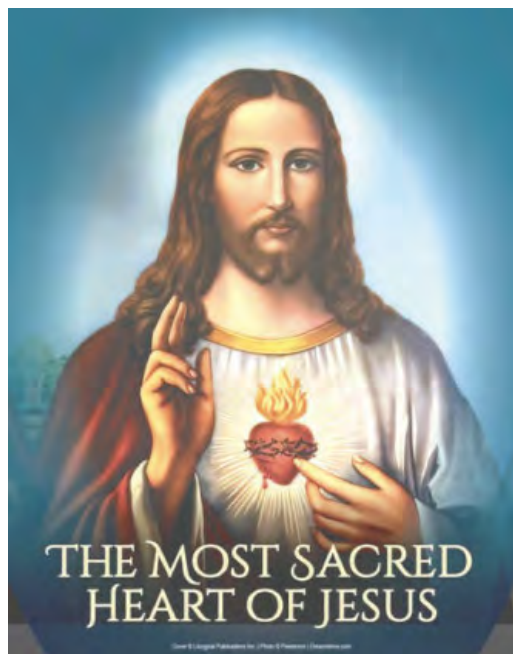


Religious Education Registration is Now Open!

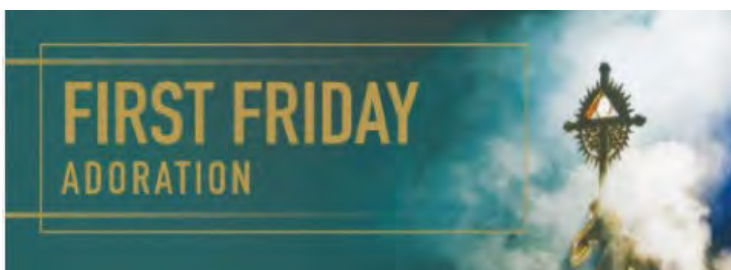
Rachel's Vineyard - Healing after Abortion

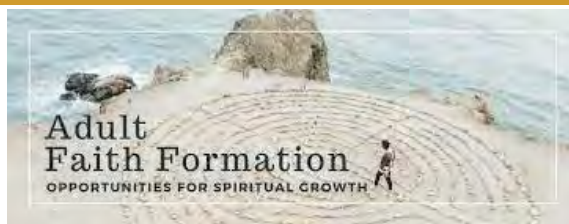

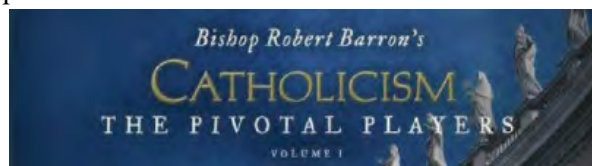

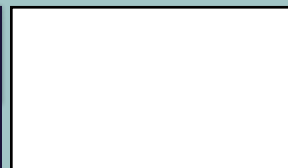
