

# Gospel Recap: "Did Jesus say to HATE my family?"

In our Gospel this week, Jesus is letting us all know that things happening at church may conflict with family life at times. Active discipleship can raise questions at home. Bad church experiences from the past can make it hard for some adults to accept a teen's good experiences at church. So if your commitment to Jesus causes some friction at home, be sure you don't misunderstand the Gospel. Jesus says to "hate" people in this passage, but according to Scripture scholars, he doesn't mean we should feel hatred towards others. Jesus means that we should be sure to choose God's will over all people and all things. And that should make us treat our family and friends with even more love. Try to remember to use these four tips if you aren't seeing eye-to-eye with your parents:



- 1. Take time to talk with and listen to your parents.
- 2. Value your family time and give it your all.
- 3. Be patient. Many parents struggle with their own faith, so that can make it harder to relate to your faith life.
- 4. Give your parents a break. It's tough raising a teenager; even a Christian one.




