





Did you Know? California act protects children online

The California Age-Appropriate Design Code Act, which was signed into law in September, requires companies to assess potential harm in how they use data from children (defined as any user under 18) in new services or features, and to enact plans to reduce risk. Companies are also banned from using minors' information in "materially detrimental" ways, such as routing searches for weight loss to photos of supermodels, and from collecting, sharing, or selling a minor's personal information by default. 

Stewardship Reflection



"Therefore, every tree that does not bear good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire." - Matthew 3:10

Do you bear good fruit for Jesus? Do you spend time in prayer or do you waste it with mindless

activity? Do you use your talent to help others or are you too busy? Do you use your treasure to support the Church or do you buy more things that go unused? Our time, talent and treasure are gifts from God. What we do with these gifts is our gift back to Him. What gifts are you planning to give to the Lord during this upcoming Christmas season?

Focusing the Gospel Matthew 3:1-12

This week's gospel introduces one of Advent's main characters: John the Baptist. We are provided a vivid description of him in that we know what he wears, what he eats. He is rough. He is unkempt. He is blunt. In other words he is a bit strange. And yet, people are drawn to him, listening to his preaching and going to be




baptized. Throughout Advent and Christmas seasons, we hear stories of God coming in ways we didn't expect, from a bizarre desert preacher to an infant born in poverty. The season insists on reminding us to keep our eyes open to the truth that God often comes disguised in interruption and inconvenience (Living Liturgy, 2022)

Faith Sharing Dialog Starters

- The gospel describes John's eccentricities with some detail. Who or what in your life do you write off as odd? How might God be present to you through them?
- Paul names God as "the God of endurance and encouragement." Where do you need endurance and encouragement this season? How can your community help?
- The psalm speaks of rescuing the poor; how can you be part of God's work of supporting those who live in poverty this Advent?
