

2023 - 2024 - Sacrament Preparation Information Meeting



Gospel Recap: "Time to See and to Believe"

Today we celebrate God's victory over death. The Resurrection proves that nothing can keep us from following Jesus if we call out for God's strength. We can stand up for what is right, though others may attack us. A life of sacrifice for others is possible and meaningful, though society says otherwise. Peace and freedom can be ours, even though we might feel controlled by pain, fear, or bad habits. This Easter, be like the disciple who entered the tomb and "saw and believed." See how God's power has raised up others. Talk to other Christians about how God has freed them from personal problems or has strengthened them to do the right thing. Where do you need strength or a new start? Do you feel trapped in a bad habit? Where do you need courage to stand up for what is right or to fix a broken relationship? Ask God for help. Your "resurrection" might not happen instantly. But through daily prayer and help from other Christians, someday you will realize that you have found new life, hope, and strength. And that will be a powerful story to tell.


Holy Land Olivewood Sale

Divine Mercy - Next Sunday







John's empty tomb narrative is mysterious. We do not see Jesus here, and not even the angel of the Synoptics reassures these witnesses about what is happening. There are only oblique signs:

a moved stone, burial cloths, and no body. The gospel ends without understanding and there is still a journey ahead of coming to understand what God has done here. Our Easter joy is not always immediate; we cannot start it on demand. But God remains with us in the journey of coming to share in this joy more fully. (Living Liturgy, 2023)

Growing in the Word: Letter to the Hebrews


