

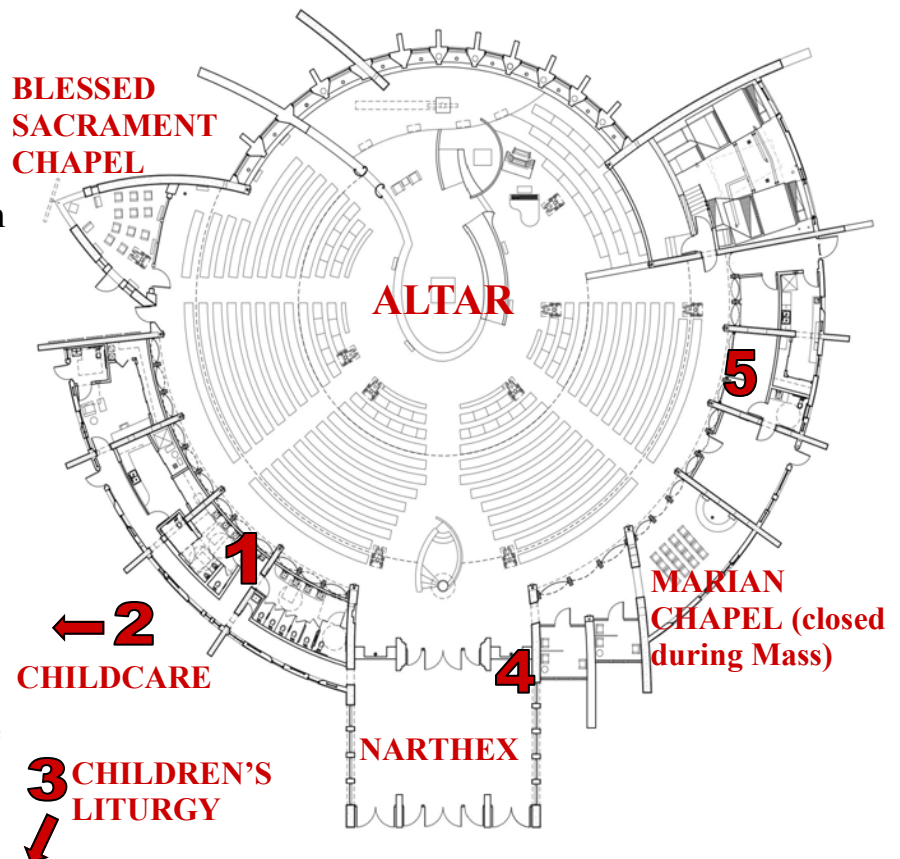

PROFESSION OF FAITH

Nicene Creed

I believe in one God, the Father almighty,
maker of heaven and earth,
of all things visible and invisible.

I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ,

true God from true God, begotten, not made,
consubstantial with the Father;

and is seated at the right hand of the Father.

and his kingdom will have no end.

Apostles' Creed:

I believe in God, the Father Almighty,
Creator of Heaven and earth;
and in Jesus Christ, his only Son our Lord,
*[At the words that follow, up to and including "the
Virgin Mary," all bow.]*
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,
born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under
Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was
buried; he descended into hell;
on the third day he rose again from the dead;
He ascended into heaven,
and is seated at the right hand of God, the
Father almighty; from there he will come to
judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic
Church, the communion of saints, the
forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the
body and life everlasting. Amen.

Memorial Acclamation

Priest: The mystery of faith:

A - We proclaim your Death, O Lord, and profess your Resurrection until you come again.

B - When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we proclaim your Death, O Lord, until you come again.

C - Save us, Savior of the world, for by your Cross and Resurrection you have set us free.

The Eucharistic Prayer concludes when the Priest sings or says "... all glory and honor is yours, for ever and ever."

All: Amen

COMMUNION RITE

STAND

Lord's Prayer

Priest: Let us pray with confidence to the Father in the words our Savior gave us.

All: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

Priest: ... as we await the blessed hope and the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ.

All: For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours, now and forever.

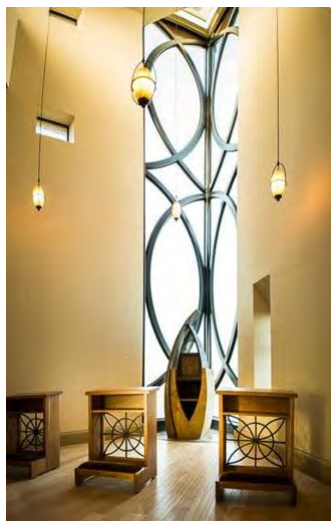
Sign of Peace

Priest: The peace of the Lord be with you always.

All: And with your spirit.

Priest: Let us offer each other a sign of peace.

Offer a handshake or greeting to those around you.



Breaking of the Bread

All: Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world: have mercy on us.

Invitation to Communion

Priest: Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb.

All: Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.

During the reception of Communion, please follow the directions of the ushers.

- *Our Communion procession begins from the back of the church.*
- *We remain standing as one community until all have received communion and the priest is seated.*
- *If you need assistance, please remain seated. Communion will be brought to you.*
- *If you are not Catholic, or are not properly disposed to take Communion, you are invited to come forward at Communion time to receive a blessing. Please cross your arms over your chest to indicate you would like a blessing.*
- *After Communion, please remain in Church until the final blessing and dismissal.*
