A Message from our Pastor

Dear Friends,

If you relied on the message from the mall, the endless emails, or the newspaper ads, you would say that Christmas is the time to shop till you drop. Buy, buy, buy. Give, give, give, give and receive gifts.

We know, however, that Christmas has a much deeper meaning. Several hundred years before Christ, Isaiah prophesied, "To us a child is born, to us a son is given" (9:5). On that day the mystery of Christmas is renewed: this child who brings salvation to the world is also born for the men and women of our own time, bringing joy and peace for all. God's gift to us was his own son, exceeding the world's fondest expectations. 
Father Beck will be presenting at all the Masses the weekend of January 11 and 12, 2020.
