

Fees for Pilgrimage

Air: \$1,400 (Air tax could go up or down until ticket is purchased.) Round trip, Los Angeles-Tel Aviv. Pilgrims may make their own separate arrangements.

Land: \$2,700 per person, double occupancy.
\$790 supplement for single occupancy
Travel Insurance highly recommended.

The above rates include:

- 10 nights accommodation on semi-pension basis (Breakfast and Dinner).
- Transportation in deluxe, air-conditioned buses on daily basis.
- English speaking guide.
- Audio guiding system
- All entrance fees for the sites mentioned in the itinerary.
- Porter fees.
- Tips for guide, bus driver, and hotel and restaurant staff.
- Farewell dinner at the Wine and Cheese Restaurant

The above rates do not include:

- Lunches at an average of \$16 per lunch.
- Donations at churches or shrines at which Mass is celebrated.
- Personal expenses such as phone calls, laundry, beverages, and medical insurance.

Payment schedule

Deposit: \$250 per person. Not refundable after July 1, 2020.

Due to limited capacity, reservations are prioritized based on when the deposit is received. Fee for air portion is due July 1, 2020.

Final payment is due on August 1, 2020. After July 15, 2020, there are no cancellations of air portion unless we have a replacement.




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Holy Land Pilgrimage Itinerary

October 4 to October 15, 2020

Monday, October 5: Ben Gurion Airport – Tiberias

Arrive at Airport in early afternoon. Meet and assistance by guide. Drive to Tiberias.

Dinner and overnight at the Sea of Galilee Hotel in Tiberias.

Tuesday, October 6: On Mary's Footsteps.

In the morning we drive to Megiddo, the site of Armageddon as outlined in the book of Revelation. From there we head north to Nazareth, where Mary lived. Mass at the Basilica of the Annunciation. After Mass we will have lunch and tour the Basilica, the Fountain of Mary, and the Synagogue. Then we go to Cana where Jesus transformed water into wine at the wedding feast. Couples will have the opportunity to renew their vows. From there back to Tiberias.

Dinner and overnight at the Sea of Galilee Hotel in Tiberias.

Wednesday, October 7: On Jesus' and the Disciples' Footsteps.

Enjoy a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum to see St. Peter's House and the synagogue built on the site of the synagogue where Jesus preached. Mass at St. Peter's Church in Capernaum. On to the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus gave his Sermon on the Mount. Continue to Tabgha, the site of the multiplication of the loaves and fish. For the hardy, a hike to the cave where Jesus spent the night in prayer. On to Nof Ginosar Kibbutz to visit the fishing boat built during the time of Jesus that was recently unearthed from the Sea of Galilee. In the afternoon we drive to Banyas, location of Caesarea Philippi where Jesus declared Peter the rock upon which He would build His Church.

Dinner and overnight at the Sea of Galilee Hotel in Tiberias.

Thursday, October 8: Tiberias – Haifa – Caesarea Maritime – Jaffa.

We leave Tiberias in the morning for Mass at Dalmanutha. Then we stop at the Baptismal site at the Jordan River. Onwards on the way we will visit the city of Haifa to visit Mount Carmel and the grotto of the prophet Elijah. Then we continue to Caesarea-by-the-Sea, the ancient Roman port. Towards the end of the day we will stop by Jaffa before returning to Jerusalem.

Dinner and overnight at the Notre Dame Center in Jerusalem.

Friday, October 9: The Wilderness: Jericho, Qumran, Dead Sea

We will head off towards the city of Jericho, the lowest city on the surface of the earth, and likewise the most continuously inhabited city in the world. After Mass we visit the ancient city, Elisha's spring, the Sycamore Tree, New City, and a view of Mt. Temptation. Then we visit Qumran and view the excavations of the Essene Monastery and the Caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Continue drive to the Dead Sea to enjoy swimming. Drive to Jerusalem.

Dinner and overnight at Notre Dame Center in Jerusalem .

Saturday, October 10: Bethlehem, Ein Karem

Drive to Bethlehem to visit the Basilica of Nativity, Chapel of St. Jerome, Milk Grotto, and the Shepherds Field. Mass at the Church of Nativity. Drive to Ein Karem to visit the Church of the Visitation and Church of St. John the Baptist.

Dinner and overnight at Notre Dame Center in Jerusalem.

Sunday, October 11: Jerusalem

In the morning after breakfast we head north towards Nablus and Samaria. We first start at the city of Nablus (Sychar or Shechem) where we will visit the Church of Jacob's well before proceeding towards Sebastia. Once we get to Sebastia we will tour the remaining remnants of the once great city of Samaria and its fort. In the early afternoon we will drive back to Jerusalem for a relaxed afternoon.

Dinner and overnight at Notre Dame Center in Jerusalem.

Monday, October 12: Old City of Jerusalem

In the morning a visit to the Western Wall, Dome of the Rock, and the Temple area. After lunch we drive to Bethany, then a walk to the Mount of the Ascension, where we get a panoramic view of the city of Jerusalem. We then descend to the bottom of the hill and visit the Basilica of the Agony or the Cave of Betrayal. Mass at Gethsemane.

Dinner and overnight at Notre Dame Center in Jerusalem.

Tuesday, October 13: The Passion of Jesus, his Last Hours

Mass at the Tomb of Jesus' resurrection at the Basilica of the Holy Sepulcher. In the morning we visit Mt. Zion and proceed to visit St. Peter in Gallicantu where we explore the ruins there, including the dungeons. Then on to the Cenacle and the Dormition Abbey. After lunch a return to the Old City. We visit St. Anne's Church. We then recite the Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa. After Stations a visit to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher.

Dinner and overnight at Notre Dame Center in Jerusalem.

Wednesday, October 14: Around the Holy City

After breakfast we head off to the Israel Museum, and there view the model city of Jerusalem at the time of our Lord, and the Dead Sea Scrolls. After Mass in Emmaus at Abu Gosh the remainder of the afternoon will be given to you to enjoy your stay in Jerusalem and explore the city at your own pace, or simply relax in your hotel. Early on in the evening the group will group in the lobby and be taken to a local restaurant for their farewell dinner to commemorate their pilgrimage to the Holy Land.

Overnight at Notre Dame Center in Jerusalem.

Thursday, October 15: Ben Gurion Airport – Home

Leave for airport for an early morning flight to Los Angeles arriving early afternoon.
