## Welcome To Saint John Fisher



### Fast and Abstinence This Wednesday

Ash Wednesday is a day of **fast** and **abstinence**. Fasting means the two secondary meals together must be less in quantity than the primary meal. All Catholics over 18 and under 60 are to fast on this day. Abstinence means that all Catholics over 14 years of age are to abstain from meat on that day and on **all Fridays of Lent**.

These requirements are not just for priests — any bishop, deacon, religious brother or sister ministering in the archdiocese must be cleared before beginning their ministry. ## Stewardship Reflection

*"But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you..." Matthew 5:44*

Love your enemies. Easier said than done, no doubt! But remember, the foundation of stewardship is prayer. When we are in close communication with God, it opens our heart and it turns our attention away from "me" and moves it towards God and others. It allows us to have a little more empathy for "our enemy." When we pray for others, even "our enemies," maybe it softens their hearts as well.

## Growing in the Word: Book of Revelation


