Saint John Fisher Parish is seeking interested parishioners to apply to become a Pastoral Council representative

The Pastoral Council consists of 15 members: the pastor, 11 adult parishioners, two youth representatives and one Pastoral Staff member. It advises the pastor regarding critical and important issues of parish life and develops an overarching vision for the parish.

The Pastoral Council meets typically on the first Wednesday of each month for about two hours, beginning at 7:00 p.m. So long as coronavirus restrictions are in place, meetings are held by Zoom remote video conference (that is, you can attend the meeting from home using your computer or smart phone).

Minimum Requirements to serve on the Pastoral Council include:

- 1. Be a baptized and confirmed Catholic and a registered member of St. John Fisher Parish; and
- 2. Have a commitment to continued growth in your relationship with Jesus Christ.

Length of Service on the Pastoral Council is two years. Any member of the Pastoral Council may serve up to two consecutive terms, for a total of four years, unless, during the second term a member is selected chair, in which case the member may serve up to a total of five years.

All parishioners are asked to seriously consider submitting their name in nomination to the Pastoral Council. The Pastoral Council, ideally, should be a true reflection of the diversity of the parish community in terms of age, ethnicity, gender, economics, educational background, and other considerations.

Nomination forms are due in the Parish Office, attention Gayle Plecha, by May 15, 2020.
