



Gospel Recap: "It's Not the Persecution. It's the Response"

You know the persecution of Christ really started a long time before Good Friday. It started the first time in history one person persecuted another. And it has continued, without pause, since Jesus himself suffered and died for us. So where can we find help if our history is filled with so much pain and persecution? We can look to Jesus's Passion and Resurrection. His Passion is really about Jesus' response. Some scholars argue that Jesus did not know he would be resurrected. So just like us, he didn't have the complete certainty of his future. Take a close look at this man during Holy Week. Despite his fears, uncertainty, and deep anguish, he focuses on God and others. Through God's power, he offers the last hours of his life as a lesson for how his friends and followers can find some meaning in every hour of their lives. Yes, Jesus's Passion still continues in our current times, but God's power still inspires people to be courageous. Look at the Ukrainians, who

are standing firm to fight for their stolen freedom. They are trying to stay focused under hostile tyranny and oppression. And our history is filled with those same types of heroes. Think of the rich history of our saints and martyrs...
