#### Young Saints <u>St. Maria Goretti</u>

Born: October 16, 1890 Died July 6, 1902 ~ Age: 11 Canonized: June 24, 1950



Saint Maria Goretti is one of the most famous young saints in Catholic tradition. She was baptized in the Church of San Francesco in Corinaldo in 1890, and received her First Holy Communion in the Church of Conca (today Borgo) in 1901.

The early historical accounts of her life describe an incident where Goretti's neighbor, a 20-year-old boy named Alessandro, tried to seduce her. However, being a devoted Christian, Saint Maria Goretti declined her neighbor's advances. Furious, Alessandro stabbed Saint Maria Goretti 14 times until she died.

Saint Maria Goretti was beatified by the Roman Catholic Church in 1947, and was declared a Saint in 1950.

Saint Maria Goretti, despite being stabbed 14 times, forgave her attacker before she died in the hospital. Historical accounts state that Alessandro, her attacker, repented afterwards

#### Did you Know? What to do if a child discloses abuse to a peer

Abuse victims often struggle to disclose what has happened to them, especially children. This struggle may be due to fear or shame, but studies show it is easier for children to disclose abuse to a trusted person. In adolescence, that is often another peer. This makes it important to educate children about what to do if a friend discloses abuse. Teach children the importance of not keeping unsafe secrets, and how to help their friends by sharing these "secrets" with a trusted parent or other adult.
