



Stewardship Reflection

"The seed sown among thorns is the one who hears the word but then the cares of the world and the lure of the riches choke the word and it bears no fruit." - Matthew 13:22

Does the lure of riches and material goods choke God out of your life? Are you so caught up in earthly activities that you have no time for God? Gratitude and generosity are virtues that we should strive to do on a daily basis. Every decision we make either takes us one step closer to God or one step further away. What we receive at Mass every Sunday should be shared with others all the other days of the week as well.

Gospel Reading, Matthew 13:1-23

In the gospel parable of the sower and the seed, Jesus lays out a variety of options for where the seeds can land and for how people can receive God's word. Some people are not prepared to absorb the word of God, like seeds on a path. Others find great joy in God's word at first but cannot sustain it. They are like seeds sown on rocky ground. Still others deal with anxieties and temptations that make it nearly impossible to truly take in the word of God, like seeds sown among thorns. The word of God does not change, but the context of the hearer makes a big difference in how well it will be received. How might you cultivate rich soil to truly hear the word of God this week? (Living Liturgy, 2023)

Faith Sharing

- Jesus names three dangers in this gospel: lack of understanding, lack of rootedness, and worldly anxiety can all prevent us from bearing fruit for Christ. Which of these feels like it carries the most risk for you?
- What anxieties do you have that threaten to smother your faith? How can you set them aside to make space for God's word to take root in your heart?
