First Communion Program

Your child's Baptism Certificate is required at time of Registration.

- Children begin First Communion preparation as early as age 6.
- First Communion Program is a two-year process.
- We support families in this sacramental preparation process. Year 2 will have several required gatherings, including parent-child classes, meetings, and retreats throughout the catechetical year.
- Children are expected to commit to one of the two session options on Sunday mornings or Tuesday evenings.

OCIA Adapted For Children Program

Your child's Birth Certificate is required at time of Registration.

- Family meeting is required for children in Year 1 and in Year 2 of OCIA.
- The OCIA Adapted For Children Program leads to Easter Vigil for the celebration of Sacraments of Initiation.

What is REPA? Religious Education Parent Association

REPA is a committee that provides prayerful input and recommendations regarding the groups and events that fall under the St. John Fisher Office of Religious Education (ORE). This group is pastoral in nature. It works from investigation, reflection, and an awareness of the needs of the community. REPA moves with an attentiveness to the spiritual well-being of families with children.

The mission of REPA is to facilitate spaces for a new vision of catechesis to occur within various groups and events that fall under the ORE and to provide funding to support those activities.
