Funeral Information Sheet

Please accept our condolences for the loss of your loved one. We understand that the entire funeral process can at times be overwhelming. As your faith community we are here to help and guide you.

The following information provides specifics in regard to costs associated with a funeral mass at St. John Fisher.

Church offering	\$300.00	Check made out to St. John Fisher
Organist/pianist	\$225.00	Check made out to the musician
Cantor	\$225.00	Check made out to the cantor
Altar Servers	\$20 per altar server	Cash on the day of the Funeral Mass. Please plan for 4 altar servers;
Optional: Barrett Hall Rental (Maximum 3 hours)	\$300.00	Check made out to St. John Fisher. Standard Room Setup for receptions. Family is responsible for leaving the hall in the condition they found it.

Interment Policies

1. If the urn containing the cremated remains of the deceased is to be interred in the St. John Fisher Columbarium, a priest from the parish will preside at the Rite of Interment.
2. If the body is to be interred at a Cemetery, the family is responsible for making arrangements with the cemetery or mortuary for a priest or other lay person to preside at the Rite of Interment. Due to parish commitments priests from the parish are not available to do gravesite interments.

Payment:

The checks for the church, musician, and cantor, along with the cash for the altar servers can be given to the Bereavement minister on the day of the funeral. They will see that the monies are distributed correctly. The check for Barrett Hall, must be given to the parish office prior to the day of the funeral.
