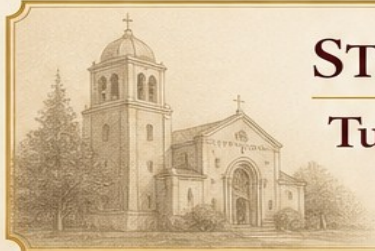


ABOUT THE TALK
