crowning me with love beyond my power to hold.

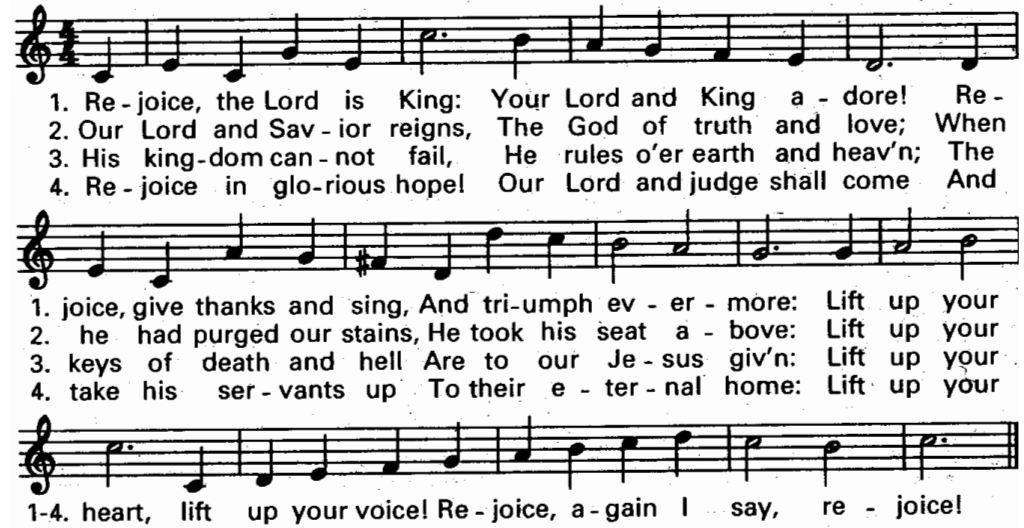
Surely your kindness and mercy follow me
