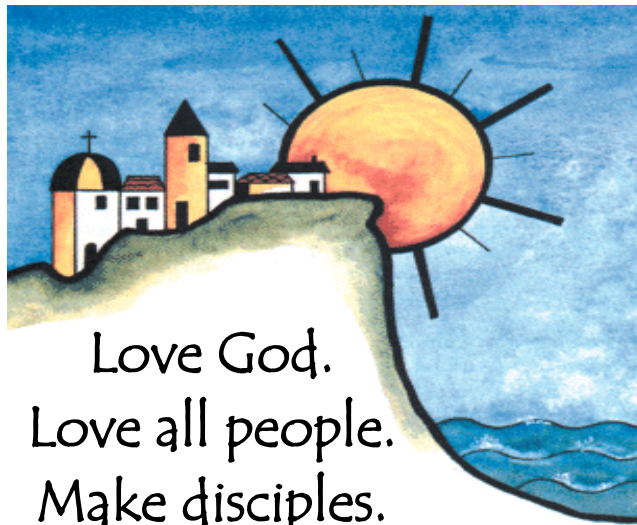

PROGRAM POLICIES FOR FAMILIES

with Children enrolled in Religious Education 2024-2025

The safety of your children is always our prime concern. The Archdiocese requires that these directives be followed by staff and volunteer catechists. Our goal is to offer the most effective process of faith sharing in an atmosphere of security.

Covid-19 Guidelines: Face masks are no longer required. All are encouraged to wear face coverings at their discretion. If your child is sick or experiencing Covid symptoms, please keep them home.

Attendance/Absence: Regular attendance is expected. If a child is ill, a parent is asked to call the RE Office at 310-377-4573, or e-mail Angelica Palaganas, apalaganas@sjf.org, before class time.

Tardiness: If your child is late, he/she must go to the Religious Education Office to pick up a tardy slip.

Early Dismissal: If there is an important reason for a child to leave class early, a parent must come to the office in person to request an early dismissal pass to hand to the catechist. A parent or designated adult should go to the child's class to pick up the child.

Dismissal Procedure

Sunday 9-10:15 am classes:

(Preschool and Kindergarten) Preschool and Kindergarten children MUST be signed in and out by a responsible adult.

Sunday 10:45-12:00 pm classes:

(Grades 1-2) Students should be picked up in their classroom.

(Grades 3-8) At the end of class, children will be dismissed from the classroom and directed to go to the designated safe pickup area. (Basketball court adjacent to the school courtyard.) Children will be supervised as they wait to be picked up. Any child not picked up ten minutes after dismissal will be brought to the R.E. Office.

Tuesday 4-5:15 pm (First Communion) classes:

At the end of class, children will be dismissed from the classroom and will wait in the school playground area. Any child not picked up ten minutes after dismissal will be brought to the RE Office.

If you cannot pick your child up: If you are delayed and unable to pick your child up on time, please let us know. We will take care of your child in the RE Office until you arrive or someone else you designate arrives to take them home.

REMIND YOUR CHILDREN not to accept a ride home with anyone, even a friend or neighbor, unless you give permission.

Earthquake/Fire: In the event of an emergency, students will be released from parish grounds only to authorized persons listed on the Disaster Preparedness Form completed at the time of registration. In the unlikely event of an evacuation of the St. John Fisher facility, students will be moved to an evacuation center as directed by emergency personnel. Staff members or volunteer catechists will remain with the students until they have been reunited with their families.

Parental Involvement: Every family is encouraged to participate in enhancing and enriching the Parish Religious Education Program. Requests for volunteer assistance on “*Service Opportunities for Families*” will also be sent by e-mail on a regular basis. *We truly appreciate your help in keeping our program safe and enjoyable for all families.*

Student Behavior: Full cooperation of all the students during RE classes is expected. Parents will be notified of any persistent discipline problems.

Guests in Class: Guests are always welcome to attend with children, as long as they cooperate with the catechist and with the goals of the program. If a Religious Education student wishes to bring a guest to class, the student’s parent must register the guest in the Office before class begins. Parents/grandparents are welcome to visit during Religious Education class time. Adults **MUST** sign in on the Visitor Log in the classroom.

Parents, you are entrusting your children to us. We take this responsibility very seriously. If any issues or problems arise that you feel need to be addressed by the staff, please do not hesitate to contact Kimberly St. Romain, 310-377-4573, ext. 136.

PRESCHOOL AND KINDERGARTEN

- All Sunday Pre-School/Kindergarten Religious Education Classes begin on **Sunday, September 22.**
- Classes will be held in the Kindergarten classroom.
- Please arrive at 8:50 am to sign your children in.
- Class ends promptly at 10:10 am.



Parent Procedures All children are to be escorted by an adult to their class. Each child must be signed in before the session and signed out by a responsible adult at the end. If an alternate adult will be signing in or signing out your child, please inform Kimberly before class time—in person, or by leaving a message in the RE Office with Angelica, 377-4573 x131. **Note:** pickup from Pre-School RE is promptly at 10:10 am. Even if 9 am Mass is not over, please leave so you can be there at 10:10 to sign your child out.



IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL FAMILIES WHOSE CHILDREN WILL BE CELEBRATING FIRST COMMUNION IN MAY 2025

Please watch your e-mail for important information regarding the Sacrament Preparation Program. There will be a required parent meeting at a later date TBD.

PLEASE NOTE: The First Communion program is a **two year program.** Only students who are in their second year of Religious Education are eligible to receive First Communion in May 2025. Eligibility is based on 2 years of preparation, NOT on grade level or age of students. The first year of preparation may have taken place at St. John Fisher or at another parish. The Sacrament Preparation program consists of attendance at parent classes during the year, and special events for the children. Calendars will be provided at the parent meeting.

★ ★ ★ Sunday Drop Off:

- Enter at gate at the top of the Crest Road Driveway.
- Drop off children at the School Courtyard (grassy area near school classrooms).
- Exit through gate.

Sunday Pick Up

- Repeat process above, picking children up where you dropped them off.
- **NO PARKING** in the Basketball Court Area at any time! Please do not leave your car to look for your child. If your child is not waiting for you, stay in the car until he or she comes out of class.
- You may park in the upper lot by Barrett Hall and walk in to pick up your child if preferred.

Volunteers are needed each Sunday to help keep the children safe during pick up! Please let us know if you can help!

Tuesday 4-5:15 pm classes:

At the end of class, children will be dismissed from the classroom and will wait in the school playground area. Any child not picked up ten minutes after dismissal will be brought to the RE Office.

These procedures are designed to keep the children safe. Please help us by driving carefully and watching out for children!
