OCIA: Christian Initiation for Adults

Sponsors companion candidates preparing to become Catholic or adult Catholics in need of Confirmation or First Communion. Team members plan and coordinate activities, hospitality, or learning sessions for candidates. Sponsors journey with a candidate, usually one to two years.

Time commitment: Varies depending upon one's gifts and availability; anywhere from one to two hours per month.

OCIA: Adapted for Children

Sponsors companion candidates and families with children over the age of 7 who are unbaptized and on a journey towards full initiation in the Catholic church. The OCIA-adapted for children is a two-year process. Team members plan and present sessions, coordinate activities and accompany the families going through this spiritual journey.

Time commitment: Varies depending on one's gifts and availability; generally, 1-2 h hours per week during the catechetical and formation process (September-May).

Pre-Baptismal Preparation Team

Help families with children under the age of 6 prepare for baptism, 2nd Monday of the month.

Time commitment: Members conduct one-hour Zoom preparation classes.

Young Adult Ministry (YAM)

An opportunity for faith formation and fellowship with other young adults in the South Bay. Please contact Ricardo Mata at 310-377-4573 x 147 for more information.

Adult Volunteers – Junior High Ministry/Edge

Journey with our young people in grades 6-8 as they grow in their relationship with Christ. Adult volunteers needed to serve as mentors, chaperones, and assist with hospitality. Training provided.

Time commitment: once or twice a month.

Catechists (Teachers) - Elementary & Junior High Religious Education

Share the teachings of the Catholic Church with children who attend public or private schools. Training provided.

Time commitment: 1 1/4 hours per week for 25 weeks plus preparation time.

Catechists (Aide/Substitute) - Preschool Religious Education

Teach three-year-old through kindergarten-age children on Sunday mornings 8:45 am - 10:15 am. Training provided on-site.

Time commitment: School year as needed.

Altar Servers

Boys and girls from grades 5 to 12 assist the celebrant at Eucharistic celebrations; training is required.

Time commitment: Servers assist, on average, at two-three Masses per month, weddings and funerals.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC)

Assist the priest in distributing Communion at all Masses. Training required with an interview and an initial four-hour training class.

Time commitment: Varies.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) to Homebound

Bring the Body of Christ to parishioners unable to attend Mass because of illness or infirmity. Training required with an interview and an initial four-hour training class.

Time commitment: 1 1/2 hours for one Sunday a month.

Hospitality

Serve donuts and coffee after Masses or special church events.

Time commitment: Less than one hour every four to six weeks.

Lectors

Proclaim the Word of God at all Sunday and weekday Masses. Must be a confirmed Catholic; training is required.

Time commitment: Two Masses per month.

Liturgical Environment Committee

Decorate the church for liturgical celebrations.

Time commitment: A few hours a month for flower arranging and sewing. Extra help is needed before Advent, Christmas, Holy Week, and Easter.

Liturgical Movement (Dance)

Open to high school teens. Offering the glory and honor due to God through the medium of dance.

Time commitment: Six to ten Masses per year with practice sessions.

Liturgy of the Word for Children

Assist in proclaiming the Liturgy of the Word at the 9:00 am Mass in a manner appropriate for grades 1 through 6.

Time commitment: Serve during Mass once every two months. Materials are provided.

Martha Ministry

Prepare the church for Sunday and special liturgies; includes care of altar cloths, vestments, candles, etc.

Time commitment: One hour a month.

Mass Sacristan

Work behind the scenes to insure all is ready and goes smoothly at Sunday Masses.

Time commitment: 60 minute training, arrive half hour before Mass begins, twice each month.

Music Ministry

Children's Choir: Children, grades 2 to 6, support and enhance the liturgical song of the assembly one Sunday a month, Christmas and Easter celebrations.

Time commitment: Rehearsals are Wednesdays 4:00 pm - 5:15 pm from September through May

Contemporary Choir/Instrumentalists: Help lead the community at 9:00 am Sunday Mass.

Time commitment: Rehearsals are Thursdays with the Parish Choir, 7:30 pm - 9:00 pm starting Thursday, September 4th through June and Sundays at 8:30 am from September through June. July and August only Sunday AM.

Parish Choir/Instrumentalists: Support and enhance the liturgical song of the assembly at 11:00 am Sunday Mass.

Time commitment: Rehearsals are Thursdays 7:30 pm - 9:00 pm and Sundays at 10:30 am. Starting Thursday, September 4th through June.

Teen Choir/Band: Support and enhance the song of the assembly at the 5:00 pm Sunday Mass through singing, playing instruments, or by running sound equipment.

Time commitment: Rehearsals are Sundays at 4:00 pm for the 5:00 pm Mass. [6th grade and up]

Teen Ushers and Greeters

Teens, grades 9-12, serve as ministers of welcome and ushers at the 5:00 pm Sunday Mass or at other Mass times. One hour of training required.

Ushers

Provide assistance to the assembly before, during, and after 5:00 pm Saturday, and 7:30 am, 9:00 am, and 11:00 am Sunday Masses.

Time commitment: Serve at two or three Sunday Masses a month.

Video Ministry

Assist in live streaming Daily 8:00 AM and Sunday 9:00 AM Masses and special events. Teams will be asked to work our video and sound equipment to capture one Mass each week.

Time commitment: One training session on our equipment (2 hours) and attendance at one Mass each week, operating the video equipment.

Time commitment: Every Friday, 6:30 PM - 8:30 PM

Spend time in prayer and meditation with our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel during the 24-hour adoration on the 1st Friday of each month, from 8:00 am on Friday until 8:00 am on Saturday.

Time commitment: One hour a month.

Once a month in the nine months from March - December a group rosary is prayed meditating on the unborn Jesus.

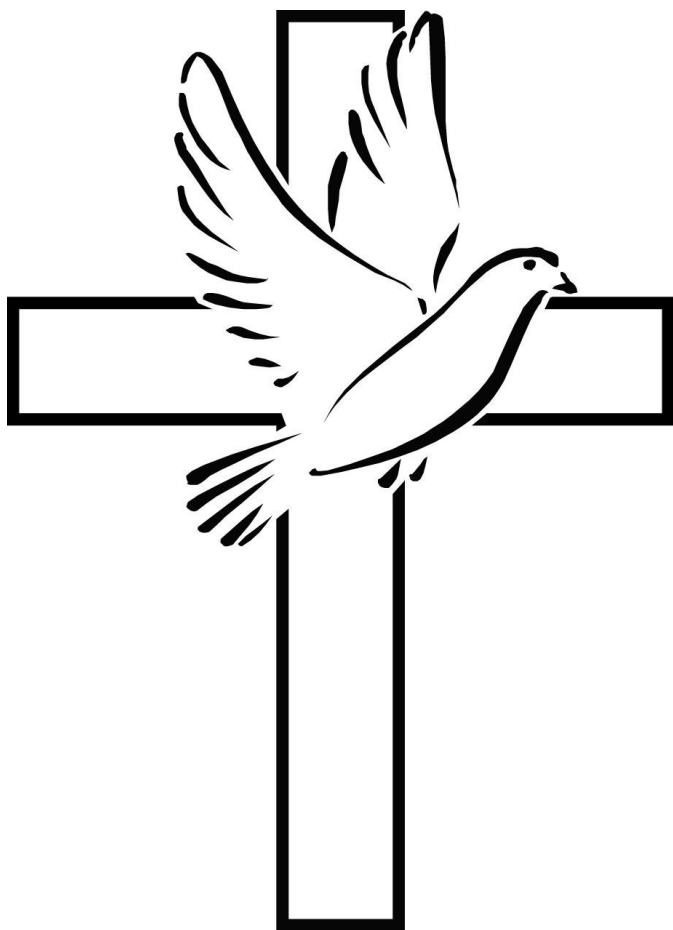
Time commitment: Meets for one hour on approximately the 25th of each month in the church after the 8:00 AM Mass.
